



## Young Artist Chamber Music Program

July 5-18, 2010

The Board of Directors of Cactus Pear Music Festival (CPMF) is pleased to announce the seventh annual **Young Artist Program** [YAP] to be held **Monday, July 5 - Sunday, July 18, 2010**. Between three and six young instrumentalists will be chosen and awarded **FULL-TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS** for an intensive two-week program. The Young Artists will form an ensemble to study and perform chamber music. The curriculum will include daily private instruction and chamber music coachings with Festival artists, lecture classes on aspects of music performance/careers, free admittance to all festival rehearsals & concerts for Fellows and family, and 8 outreach performance opportunities **including the final two San Antonio Festival concerts**.

### Eligibility for 2010 [instrumentation varies each year]

Serious 14 through 18 year-old **violin, viola, cello, flute, and clarinet students**, and **piano students** *between the ages of 14 and 20*, who live in or near San Antonio, Texas, may apply. (*Room and board not included, but home stays may be arranged if commuting is an impossibility.*) Individuals as well as pre-formed groups will be considered for acceptance. *Pianists MUST prepare the two short chamber music pieces available online (see Audition Checklist below.)*

### Course of study over two weeks

- Seven to eight 50-minute private lessons with Festival artists
- Eight to ten 1-hour chamber music coachings with Festival artists
- Two daily chamber ensemble rehearsals with at least one supervised by the Education Director
- One lecture/master class given by Festival artist
- Young Artists will observe open rehearsals and attend 1 or 2 community outreach performances given by the Festival artists
- Eight performance opportunities for the Young Artist group (Young Peoples Concerts, retirement communities, churches, synagogues, etc.)
- Young Artists will be showcased on the final two San Antonio Festival concerts
- Two small group lunch sessions with the Festival artists

### Festival Artist coaches will include, among others:

Fred Edelen, Associate Principal Cello, Concertgebouw, Amsterdam; Dave Harding, Professor of Viola, University of British Columbia, Vancouver; James Winn, Professor of Piano, University of Nevada, Reno; Peter Miyamoto, Professor of Piano, University of Missouri, Columbia; Ilya Shterenberg, Principal Clarinet, San Antonio Symphony; Stephanie Jutt, Professor of Flute, University of Wisconsin-Madison.

### Application and Audition Checklist

All application materials are **due by April 16, 2010**. Only applicants who audition *in person* will be considered for participation. Auditions will occur in San Antonio by appointment only on Saturday, April 24. Applicants should prepare two contrasting solo works (*accompanist not necessary*) and *may* be asked to sight read chamber music. **Pianists**, in addition, will be asked to prepare two short chamber music excerpts that are available online.
